

1st Reading: 1 Corinthians 15, 12-20 read by Valerie Turner Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised; and if Christ has not been raised, then our proclamation has been in vain and your faith has been in vain. We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified of God that he raised Christ—whom he did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised. If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have died in Christ have perished. If for this life only we have hoped in Christ, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died.

Vacancy update - next steps: we confirm that our advertisement for a new vicar is on the Diocesan website, our own website and in the Church Times. The closing date for applications is 5 March 2025. We hope and pray that there is sufficient interest in the vacancy to generate a number of applications and among those suitable applicants to be interviewed. However, nothing is guaranteed. Applicants who progress to the interview stage will be interviewed by a panel on Tuesday 25 March. The panel will include representatives from the Diocese and Mark Jones and Lindsay Woods from Aldenham.

If we do not find our new vicar at the end of this process the vacancy will be re-advertised.

As you will appreciate details of the appointment process are confidential - including how many applicants - so apologies in advance if you have any questions that cannot be answered at this stage.
